### MOUNTING

*IT'S ADVISABLE THAT ONLY EXPERTS HANDLE THIS CONTAINER*

<p>OPEN THE TOP OF THE CARTON AND PUT CARTON FLIER AS IN THE PICTURE</p>	<p>PUT THE DISPENSE HEAD ON AND TURN CLOCKWISE TO LOCK</p>	<p>PUSH DOWN THE HANDLE</p>	<p>THE PET KEG IS READY TO BE USED</p>

*USE A "AMERICAN SANKEY" "D" FITTING WITH NEW JOINTS. THE INTERNAL PRESSURE SHOULD NOT EXCEED 3 BARS (SPARKLING WINES). THE PET KEG IS SENSIBLE TO SHARP OBJETS AND FREE FALLS. IF DAMAGED, IT COULD BURST.*

***Use caution: the valve is made of plastic, handle gently!***

			
<p>PULL UP THE HANDLE OF THE DISPENSE HEAD</p>	<p>TURN THE DISPENSE HEAD COUNTERCLOCKWISE AND REMOVE IT</p>	<p>THE KEG HAS A VALVE THAT RELEASES THE CO2, IF PRESSED IN HIS SPECIAL ADAPTER. IT COULD CAUSE SOME NOISE.</p>	<p>FLATTEN THE KEG AND RECYCLE ACCORDING TO REGULATIONS</p>
