Cantina di Venosa

Venosa is a city that rises north of Lucania and is famous for having given birth to Orazio and Prince Charles Gesualdo from Venosa. The Cellar is one of the most renowned wineries in the Southern part of Italy. Founded in 1957, from 27 promoters, it is now a force of 400 winegrowers with an area of 800 hectares, most in the municipality of Venosa, which is the largest producer of Aglianico grapes in the Vulture area.

Grape: 100% Aglianico del Vulture



Wine-making: Maceration in small stainless steel containers for 7-8 days at between 23° to 26° C.; fermentation to dryness and malolactic fermentation completed in stainless steel tanks.

Maturation: Partly in small French oak barrels and partly in Slovenian oak 25 and 50 hectolitre casks for 12 months.

Tasting notes.

A modern fine Aglianico very well structured:

- Colour: ruby red with garnet hints;
- Bouquet: raspberry and blackcurrant fruit with spicy notes;
- Taste: dry, persistent, very pleasant harmony.

Food matching: a versatile wine to accompany Mediterranean dishes, grilled meats and cheese.
